2004 COACHES MESSAGE

When the Titans Girls Soccer program began in 2003, a theme of *“a new tradition begins”* was established with a focus on the unique opportunity for the players to develop the culture, tradition, and reputation of the Tuscarora Girls Soccer program. As we entered this past fall season, the players set a goal of *“Setting the Titan Tradition.”* Three months later, it is obvious that they have done this in spectacular fashion. On November 20, the Titans were crowned state champions. Could there possibly be a better way to establish the traditions of a program?

The tradition they have set is one of excellence. From the first time that we met in June 2003, we have held as our mission the idea of *“Valuing Excellence.”* With a State, Regional, and Conference title to our name in this, our first varsity season, the girls have obviously reached this level on the field of play. More importantly though, the girls have demonstrated the idea of “Valuing Excellence” in all aspects of their life. During the first term, the Varsity team carried a team GPA of 3.76 while the Junior Varsity program carried a GPA of 3.51. Throughout the fall, the girls have modeled excellence in the classroom, on the athletic field, and in their daily school and community lives. This is the tradition that the 2004 Tuscarora Girls Soccer team has set and will serve as the model for future teams in this program.

As we took the field in August, it was very obvious that the talent level of the players in the program would give us the opportunity to have a very successful fall season. Talk of a state championship has been in the air since before the school opened. With that said, talent is just one ingredient in the recipe for success. Each year, there are a number of teams who truly have the talent to be champions. In the end though, it is a variety of other character traits that will determine who is left standing in the end. The champion must demonstrate the maturity and discipline to get through the toughest moments of the season. They must have the resolve to make it through true adversity, and they must develop a chemistry that allows each individual to put the group ahead of themselves for the greater good.

For the Titans, these questions were answered with flying colors. Most programs generally expect their success to be determined by the strength of their senior class. For us, this was not possible. Not only did we not have any seniors, we only had 2 juniors with 16 freshmen and sophomores. That’s right, 16 players who were still eligible to compete at the junior varsity level populated our varsity roster. So how we did we get to this point. It begins with strong leadership. Not only did we receive this from our captains, Amanda Meehan and Leeza Constantoulakis, but also each player on our roster contributed as a leader in their own special way. This enabled us to overcome our youth and play with a maturity level beyond our years.

As a coach, there is no complaint that bothers me more than teams that use injuries as an excuse for their performance. The idea that “we lost, but we were missing...” is to say the least, repulsive. It is an excuse and nothing more. In a team sport, great teams are defined by the contributions of the entire roster. Teams that have this strength and attitude can overcome any setback. The Titans defined this ability to overcome adversity. From losing one of the best players in the program, Kristin Remsburg, for the entire season to a knee injury, to knowing we would be without our 2003 Team MVP, Amanda Meehan, for a good portion of the season would be a reason for failure for many programs. Add to this, losing Rachel Micol for half the league season and many other injuries, and you had a season ready for disaster with a lesser group. For

the Titans though, success was never a question. It was simply; we miss her, but let's go. Each and every player stepped up and kept us moving forward without ever looking back. The team's success this year is truly defined by the strength and will of the entire group to overcome what most would perceive as adversity.

Finally, a championship team must create an environment in which players are willing to sacrifice their needs and desires for the good of the team. Anytime you are able to put together a team with the talent in this room, this must be a concern, as talented players will have to take on roles that they are not accustomed to filling. The quality of character that each Titan demonstrated during their own adversity throughout the season is what got us to this point. Each player was willing to make sacrifices to help the team get to its final destination. Without this sacrifice, our season would have ended much earlier.

So, the 2004 Tuscarora Girls Soccer team has set a tradition of excellence for those who come after them and have continued to define what we like to call "Titan Pride." The question now is, what is next. With a move up to 3A and a more difficult schedule in 2005, next year will be an exciting one. The responsibility of the 2005 Titans will be to continue to carry this wonderful tradition of "Valuing Excellence." If they do that, the coming years will be filled with many more memorable moments.

I would like to thank all the members of the 2004 Titans AND their families for a wonderful inaugural varsity season. It has been an honor to be associated with each and every one of these young ladies! They have planted the seeds of something special here at THS. I can't wait to see what the future brings.
